

NJSBA Candidate Kit Now Available Online

New Jersey's 2011 Annual School Election will take place on Wednesday, April 27, when approximately 1,500 school board seats will be on the ballot throughout the state.

For the convenience of school board secretaries and prospective candidates, NJSBA has posted its annual Candidate Kit online, at www.njsba.org/candidacy.

The kit provides resources for citizens considering running for their local school board, including:
