

Preschool Online Learning Letter

Families,

As we begin full remote learning without the use of packets, I have created a cover letter breaking down which platforms we will be using, their hyperlinks and how to log into each one. Each child will have their own personal login codes for each platform. Those codes will be emailed to you directly.

Please know that the activities will differ depending on enrollment status (half/full day). Some programs will adjust depending on the progress the child is displaying so they can move at their own pace. With that said, please allow your child to complete activities as independently as possible so the program can tailor itself to meet the needs of the child. If you have any further questions please do not hesitate to reach out.

SeeSaw:

1. Students go to <https://app.seesaw.me> on a computer
Or install the Seesaw Class App on an iOS or Android device.
2. Students tap "I'm a Student".
3. Students type in their text code to access their Seesaw account.

Reading Eggs/Math Seeds:

- STEP 1: Go to www.readingeggs.com and click 'Login'.
- STEP 2: Enter your child's login details
- STEP 3: Pick Reading Eggs or Math Seedlings depending on the assignment you are completing. Please be aware which platform you are attempting to engage with.

Boom Learning:

- STEP 1: You will not need to access boom learning through their website. All items for BOOM learning will be presented in Seesaw. Follow the above directions to access Seesaw.
- STEP 2: Go to the ANNOUNCEMENTS tab in SeeSaw. You will find it above your child's name.
- STEP 3: When using BOOM learning via Seesaw, have your BOOM log in information available. Click the activity.
- STEP 4: Login using your BOOM Learning login information.

Note: At any time, when your child requires a break from online learning, it is encouraged to do so. Additionally, all contents within the lesson schedule are modified based on student enrollment status (Half and full day sessions) within the cover sheets AND in the actual assigned instructions.
