#### A1. <u>RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR A SPECIAL SCHOOL DISTRICT ELECTION TO BE HELD ON</u> <u>DECEMBER 12, 2017</u>

**BE IT RESOLVED**, by The Board of Education of the Borough of East Rutherford, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. A special election of the legal voters of this School District shall be held on December 12, 2017 between the hours of 6:00 A.M. and 8:00 P.M., in the School District at the places and for the purposes hereinafter provided.
- 2. The following school bond proposal shall be voted upon at the special school election:

#### PROPOSAL

**BE IT RESOLVED**, that The Board of Education of the Borough of East Rutherford, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey shall

(A) undertake the following improvements (including related work) in the School District (the "Project"): (1) <u>Faust Intermediate School, Faust Annex and McKenzie School Renovations</u> – building renovations and alterations, conversion of existing spaces to new uses, building system improvements, installation of an elevator (at Faust Intermediate School), construction of additional parking and a covered walkway (at the Faust Annex), roof repairs and partial replacement (at McKenzie School) and, if bond or note proceeds are available, the acquisition of new furniture, equipment and apparatus required therefor, and (2) <u>Addition to Faust Intermediate School</u> – construction of a three story school building addition adjacent to Faust Intermediate School, including site improvements and, if bond or note proceeds are available, the acquisition of original furniture, equipment and apparatus required for such addition;

(B) expend therefor not exceeding \$31,560,400; and

(C) issue bonds or notes of the School District for the Project in the principal amount not exceeding \$31,560,400. The Commissioner of Education (the "Commissioner") has determined that the final eligible costs of the Project are \$12,856,484, which has been allocated by the Commissioner as follows: Faust Intermediate School Renovations project - \$10,113,900; Faust Annex Renovations project - \$-0-; McKenzie School Renovations project - \$2,515,500; and Faust School Addition project - \$227,084. The State of New Jersey, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7G-9, has approved debt service aid equal to 40% of the annual debt service due with respect to the final eligible costs of the Project. The School District may transfer a portion of the proposed local share cost of one project to another under circumstances permitted by statute. The Project

includes \$18,703,916 (consisting of \$480,000 related to the Faust Annex Renovations project and \$18,223,916 related to the Faust School Addition project) for school facility construction elements in addition to the facilities efficiency standards developed by the Commissioner, or that are not otherwise eligible for State support pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7G-5(g).

3. The polling places for the election (described by reference to the election districts used at the last General Election in the Borough of East Rutherford, County of Bergen, New Jersey) are established and have been designated as follows, and no person shall vote at the election elsewhere than at the polling place designated for the voters of the election district in which he or she resides:

Polling Place at the East Rutherford Civic Center (Upper Level) located at 37 Vreeland Avenue in the School District for legal voters residing within General Election District Nos. 1 and 2, Borough of East Rutherford.

Polling Place at the Grove Street Fire House Meeting Room located at 312 Grove Street in the School District for legal voters residing within General Election District No. 3, Borough of East Rutherford.

Polling Place at the Carlton Avenue Fire House Meeting Room located at 107 Carlton Avenue in the School District for legal voters residing within General Election District No. 4, Borough of East Rutherford.

- 4. This Board of Education hereby approves and adopts the proposal set forth in Section 2 hereof and, subject to the approval of the legal voters of the school district, hereby determines to carry out the same. The Superintendent of Schools, the Board Secretary and other representatives of the Board of Education are hereby authorized to take all necessary actions in connection with the special school election.
- 5. This Board of Education hereby acknowledges and confirms that, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 18A:24-16 and 18A:24-17, a supplemental debt statement has been prepared as of the date of this resolution by the chief financial officer of the Borough of East Rutherford, being every municipality comprised within the School District, giving effect to the proposed authorization of bonds of the School District in the amount stated in the proposal set forth in Section 2 hereof and that the supplemental debt statement has been filed in the office of the Clerk of the Borough of East Rutherford and in the office of the Board Secretary of this Board of Education prior to the adoption of this resolution. This Board of Education hereby directs the Board Secretary of the Board of Education to have the supplemental debt statement filed in the office of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs prior to the date of the special election authorized herein.
- 6. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education of East Rutherford (the Board) caused an annual audit of the district's accounts and financial transactions to be conducted by a public school accountant for the 2016-2017 fiscal year pursuant to NJSA 18A:23; and

**WHEREAS,** said "Comprehensive Annual Financial Report" and "Auditor's Management Report" for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2017, are required to be filed in duplicate with the Office of the Commissioner, pursuant to NJSA 18A:23-3; and

**WHEREAS,** a presentation of the audit with discussion of the district's fiscal status, audit findings and recommendations was made to the Board and public by members of the audit firm of Lerch, Vinci & Higgins, LLP at the board meeting of October 19, 2017; and

**WHEREAS,** the presentation allowed for a public discussion of the audit results including the district's overall financial position, reserved, unreserved and excess surplus fund balances, funding of worker's compensation and compensated absences, and food services' operations; and

**WHEREAS,** the presentation further allowed for a public discussion of the audit results including the district's four (4) audit findings and recommendations, one (1) which was a repeat recommendation, none (0) which was of a significant deficiency, none (0) which was of a material deficiency and all are addressed in the Corrective Action Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the synopsis of the CAFR was available to the public at the October 19, 2017 board meeting with copies of the synopsis available at the offices of the School Business Administrator upon request; and

**WHEREAS**, a Corrective Action Plan has been drafted and disseminated to the board and appropriate parties by the School Business Administrator addressing each of the four (4) audit recommendations presented in the Auditor's Management Report in response to their recommendations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Corrective Actions Plan were provided prior to the board meeting to the Finance Committee for their review, comments and support and providing such support on the action within the Corrective Action Plan;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that The Board of Education of East Rutherford accepts the June 30, 2017 audit and approves the Corrective Action Plan for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2017; and

#### **Recommendation 1**

Disposition:

The District enhances compliance with the DRTRS reporting guidance to ensure only eligible students are reported as receiving transportation services.

## F4. COST REIMBURSEMENT FOR FOOD SERVICE MANAGEMENT SERVICES

**WHEREAS,** the Department of Agriculture sent a notice on June 14, 2017 to New Jersey school districts participating in the National School Lunch program announcing a significant change in the procurement protocol for the contracting of food service management companies that operate breakfast and lunch programs for New Jersey public schools, and

WHEREAS, this new procurement protocol would change the fundamental basis for awarding food service management contracts from a "Cost Reimbursement Basis" to a "Fixed Price Basis" for contract awards, and

**WHEREAS**, the East Rutherford Board of Education has engaged staff and the community year after year to provide a local food service program that addresses and meets the needs of our children, and

**WHEREAS**, the East Rutherford Board of Education credits the current "Cost Reimbursement" procurement method as the reason why the local school district can design a food service program that has the flexibility of meeting the needs of its children, and

**WHEREAS**, the East Rutherford Board of Education declares that the "Fixed Price" procurement system would dramatically reduce the school district's ability to change or alter its food service operations without the need to rebid for food service management services, and

**WHEREAS**, the East Rutherford Board of Education further declares that the "Fixed Price" procurement method would impact the quality of the meals served to its children and therefore impact the participation of children in our breakfast and lunch program, and

**WHEREAS,** the East Rutherford Board of Education further declares that the "Fixed Price" procurement method may limit the number of competitive proposals received by boards of education, and

**WHEREAS**, the East Rutherford Board of Education rejects the Department of Agriculture's underlying reasons for making this change without giving NJ School Districts the opportunity to address their concerns in an attempt to keep this procurement method in place, and

**WHEREAS**, the East Rutherford Board of Education prefers an optional procurement system for securing Food Service Management Companies whereby the district could choose either Cost Reimbursement" or "Fixed Price" as the basis for contract awards.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the East Rutherford Board of Education hereby requests the Department of Agriculture to reconsider its plans to move the basis of awarding Food Service Management contracts to a "Fixed Price" basis and allow the option of continuing to use a "Cost Reimbursement procurement model; or in the alternative, a "Fixed Price" procurement method, and
