Pilot Program for New Drop-off Procedures

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Please be aware that as of **Monday, April 3, 2017**, there will be new drop off guidelines at McKenzie School. There will be staff to guide the students into the building from 8:10 A.M. to 8:35 A.M. If you are dropping your child off late, please legally park and escort your child into the Main Office. The purpose of these new guidelines is to improve the efficiency of our drop off and ensure child safety.

- All 3rd and 4th grade students are to be dropped at the designated **Wall Street** location beginning at 8:10 A.M. and no later than 8:35 A.M. These students will utilize the door which is closest to Totland. All students will proceed directly into the auditorium.
- All $K 2^{nd}$ grade students are to be dropped off at the designated **New Street** location beginning at 8:10 A.M. and no later than 8:35 A.M. All students will proceed directly into the auditorium.
 - If you have children in multiple grade levels you may utilize either drop off location.
 - There is a parking lot at the entrance to Elm Street off Paterson Avenue.
 - ➤ <u>DO NOT</u> use residential, firehouse, or other driveways to park your car.
 - > <u>DO NOT</u> park illegally, block driveways, or interfere with the traffic flow.
 - > Students should only be dropped-off at the posted locations on New Street (yellow line on New Street) and the designated area on Wall Street (left side only by Totland).
 - Only have your child exit your vehicle on the <u>curb side</u> for both drop off locations (Please do not get out of your vehicles for your safety and for the efficiency of drop off).
 - ➤ <u>DO NOT</u> drop off students on Carlton Avenue.
 - > Follow police instructions and marked areas.
 - Wait in line and do not cut around other cars to drop off.
 - ➤ Parents are not to enter the building unless their child is tardy.

 (A student is considered tardy after 8:35 A.M.)
