Eligibility Requirements

To be considered for the East Rutherford PTA Scholarship, applicants:

- Must be a current East Rutherford NJ resident and fulltime student graduating Becton High School in the class of 2025
- Must have attended 1st to 8th grade (or at least 3 years of that range) in the East Rutherford School District public schools
- Must maintain a minimum 2.5 Grade Point Average on a 4.0 scale, or in the top 40% of class in High School
- Must be applying or attending a two- or four-year accredited College or University

Application Submission

Applications may be accessed on the PTA website at http://www.erboe.net/domain/124 in pdf format for printing. Pre-printed applications may also be obtained at the Guidance Office at Becton Regional HS.

Applications must be received or postmarked or submitted online by **May 9th, 2025**. Applications received after this date will not be considered.

The application becomes complete and valid only when you have returned all documentation indicated. All documents should be received in one package sent by the applicant.
