- The \$30.9 Million Bond Referendum will fund critical facilities needs
- If the referendum is approved, the district will receive State Aid totaling \$5.1 million



- The State Aid will reduce the total cost of the referendum to \$25.8 million
 - Tax impact* is:
 - \$308/year
 - \$26/month
 - 87¢/day

*For a home assessed at the borough average of \$316,815; additional \$8/for every \$100,000 over the average.

8 Repairs & Improvements

If the referendum passes on March 13, some of the repairs and improvements will include:

- Additional classrooms and a decrease in class size
 - Enable out-of-district students to return to district
 - Enable age-appropriate learning enviornment
- New security entrances
- Ability to better monitor/control HVAC
- Replacing leaking pipes and reduce ongoing repair costs
- A reduction of out-of-district tuition costs
- A reduction of out-of-district transportation costs
- Allocating savings to additional staff/program costs
- Increasing ADA-accessibility
