

# EAST RUTHERFORD SCHOOL DISTRICT BOND REFERENDUM



## YOU NEED TO KNOW

- The **\$30.9 Million** Bond Referendum will fund critical facilities needs
- The State Aid will reduce the total cost of the referendum to **\$25.8 million**
- If the referendum is approved, the district will receive **State Aid totaling \$5.1 million**
- Tax impact\* is:
  - **\$308/year**
  - **\$26/month**
  - **87¢/day**



*\*For a home assessed at the borough average of \$316,815; additional \$8/for every \$100,000 over the average.*

## 8 Repairs & Improvements

If the referendum passes on March 13, some of the repairs and improvements will include:

- Additional classrooms and a decrease in class size
  - Enable out-of-district students to return to district
  - Enable age-appropriate learning environment
- New security entrances
- Ability to better monitor/control HVAC
- Replacing leaking pipes and reduce ongoing repair costs
- A reduction of out-of-district tuition costs
- A reduction of out-of-district transportation costs
- Allocating savings to additional staff/program costs
- Increasing ADA-accessibility

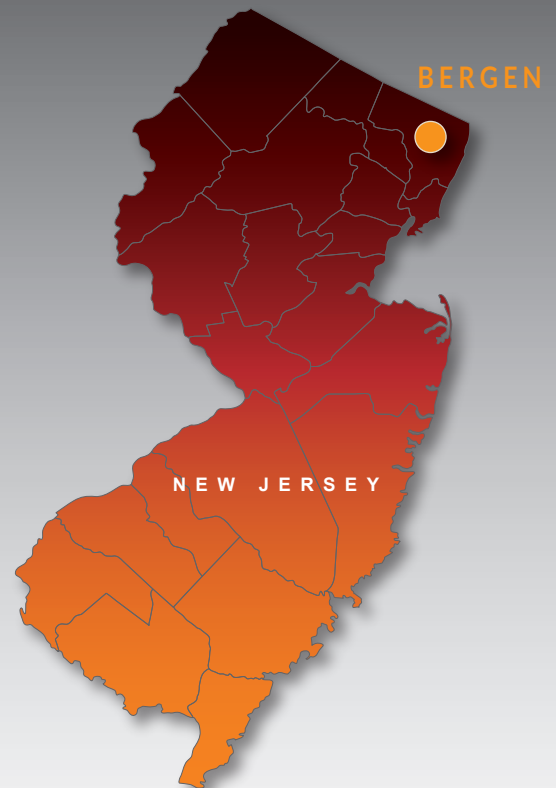
## Things to Know About Voting
